**SUBJECT:** Resolution approving execution of a renewal contract with Blair Romer, M.D. for direct clinical and other psychiatric services for clients of Nevada County Behavioral Health Department for the term of July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2028 with the maximum contract amount not to exceed \$265,000 for Fiscal Year 2026/27 and shall not exceed \$265,000 for Fiscal Year 2027/28 for a total 2-year maximum of \$530,000.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached Resolution.

**FUNDING:** These services are mandated. Funding is available from Medi-Cal Federal Financial Participation (FFP) and Realignment. Services are within the department's budget. There are no county general funds required in the agreement.

**BACKGROUND:** This is a renewal contract for Dr. Blair Romer to continue to provide psychiatric services for the County's Behavioral Health Department. Under this agreement, the Contractor will provide approximately three days per week of direct clinical psychiatric services including the examination, diagnosis, and treatment of clients receiving County Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder services. The Contractor determines therapeutic and medication needs, develops treatment plans, participates in case conferences, consults with clinical staff regarding support services, placement and treatment options, prescribes and administers medications, and provides conservatorship evaluations as needed by the County.

It is recommended that the attached contract renewal be approved as the services provided will help to ensure adequate psychiatric coverage for the department.
