

## RESOLUTION No. 25-505

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH THOMSON REUTERS FOR ONLINE LEGAL RESEARCH, LEGAL DOCUMENT PREPARATION SOFTWARE, AND RELATED SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$92,719.00 FOR A SUBSCRIPTION PERIOD OF 36 MONTHS AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Nevada County District Attorney's Office currently holds a five-year agreement with Thomson Reuters for subscription services, previously approved under Resolution 24-390, covering the period from July 1, 2024, through June 30, 2029; and


WHEREAS, the District Attorney's Office now seeks to enter into a new three-year agreement with Thomson Reuters, which will supersede the existing five-year agreement; and

WHEREAS, the new agreement includes upgraded subscription services featuring enhanced tools and advanced technology that are essential for supporting legal research and attorney work product; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the new three-year agreement is \$92,719.00, with the agreement becoming effective upon the date of execution and continuing for a period of 36 months; and

WHEREAS, online legal research tools and related technology-based services provide a cost-effective and efficient means of supporting in-house legal research and ensuring attorneys have access to current and comprehensive legal resources.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Agreement between the County of Nevada and Thomson Reuters for online legal research and legal document preparation software, in the amount of \$92,719.00, and effective upon the date of execution for a term of 36 months, is hereby approved in the agreement attached hereto; and the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is authorized to execute the agreement.
