SUBJECT: Resolution accepting the FY 2025 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services funded through the U.S. Department of Homeland Security in the amount of \$142,039 with a 100% match requirement for use during the period July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2027, retroactively authorizing the Director of Emergency Services to execute the grant agreement and all additional documents required to fulfill the requirements of the grant on behalf of the County of Nevada.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the Resolution.

FUNDING: FY 2025 assignment of federal grant funds passed through the State in the amount of \$142,039 and requires \$142,039 in County matching funds. These funds will be received in the Office of Emergency Services budget. The revenue and expenditures for the EMPG have been included in the Fiscal Year 2026/27 Budget.

BACKGROUND: Funds provided under the EMPG must be used to support activities that contribute to the Operational Area's capability to prevent, prepare for, mitigate against, respond to, and recover from emergencies and disasters, whether natural or manmade. The performance period for the FY 2025 EMPG is from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2027. This grant agreement is only now coming to the Board because the subaward notification was not received until May 12, 2026 and the grant performance period aligns with the State's award.

The amount approved for Nevada County is \$142,039 with a 100% match requirement. The match requirement will be met through budgeted General Fund expenditures within the proposed Fiscal Year 2026/27 Office of Emergency Services (OES) budget.
