SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing application and acceptance of funds for the County for Fiscal year 2025/26 for the Transitional Housing Program (THP) Round 7 and the Housing Navigator and Maintenance Program (HNMP) Round 4.

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: This is a State of California Allocation Acceptance for \$26,645 for THP Round 7 and \$9,563 in HNMP Round 4 grant money. There are no county general fund dollars required in the Agreement.

BACKGROUND: Pursuant to the following statutes:

- Transitional Housing Program's (THP) item 2240-102-0001 of Section 2.00 of the Budget Act of 2025 (Chapter 22 of the Statutes of 2024) and Chapter 11.7 (commencing with HSC 50807) of Part 2 of Division 31 of the Health and Safety Code, and
- The Housing Navigation and Maintenance Program's (HNMP) item 2240-103-0001 of Section 2.00 of the Budget Act of 2025 (Chapter 22 of the Statutes of 2024) and Chapter 11.8 (commencing with HSC 50811) of Part 2 of Division 31 of the Health and Safety Code,

The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) has allocated designated funding to counties for use by county child welfare services agencies under THP and HNMP.

It is recommended that the Board approve this item as the funds will help young adults to secure and maintain housing. HCD requires certain language be used in the Resolution to receive funding.
