BACKGROUND: The County's vision, mission and value statements, as adopted by the Board each year, outline the dedication to outstanding public service with the mission to work with the community to develop sound and innovative public policy, provide strong leadership and deliver excellent services in a fiscally responsible manner. To recognize members of the public who exhibit and promote the county's vision of public service through strong leadership, the Nevada County Youth Leadership Award recognizes local youth for their outstanding service to the community. The awardee will receive a Challenge Coin, a certificate, and public recognition by the Board of Supervisors.

Julian Hall, a senior at Truckee High School (THS), has proven to be a model leader both on and off the football field. As quarterback for the THS football team, Julian played a critical role in guiding the team to a 40-13 victory over SLAM Academy on November 1, 2022 to become the Class 3A Nevada State Champions. The game was played at Allegiant Stadium in Las Vegas, and following his outstanding performance, Julian was named MVP. Nominated by his teammates, Julian also served as the team captain for the season. Off the field, Julian is also an exemplary student as evidenced by a 4.2 GPA and being named an "All-American Football Scholar". Julian's exceptional academic performance directly contributed to the THS Football Team winning the Academic State Championship in Nevada 3A Football with a combined 3.62 GPA. Julian is a three-time recipient of the "OKG Award (Our Kinda Guy)" which is awarded to the individual who "takes it from the class to the grass".

This fall, Julian will be a freshman at Cal Poly San Luis Obispo, and he has been accepted into the prestigious School of Architecture and Environmental Design. Therefore, it is recommended the Board approve the award of the Nevada County Youth Leadership Award to Julian Hall.
