

## RESOLUTION No.

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF CAPITAL ASSETS OF TWO (2) AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) ACCESSIBLE CLASS B – 12 PASSENGER CUTAWAY BUSES FOR USE IN ADA PARATRANSIT AND DIAL-ARIDE SERVICE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$279,999.25 FROM MODEL 1 COMMERCIAL VEHICLES VIA CALACT COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT NO. 20-01

WHEREAS, the application for the purchase of capital equipment (paratransit vehicles) was submitted by the Transit Services Division, and approval of the project application and funding award has been received from the Department of Transportation/Division of Rail and Mass Transportation Section 5311 Coronavirus Relief and Response Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA) grant funding in the amount of \$452,890; and

WHEREAS, the FTA Section 5311 grant funding supports the Transit Services Division Paratransit Vehicle Replacement Plan as approved by the Board in Resolution No. 13-149; and

WHEREAS, the Transit Services Division has obtained a competitive sales quote from Model 1 Commercial Vehicles for the two (2) ADA accessible Class B-12 passenger cutaway buses in the amount of \$267,305; and

WHEREAS, the Transit Services Division wishes to purchase two (2) ADA accessible Class B – 12 passenger cutaway buses to replace two similar vehicles currently owned by the contractor Paratransit Services, and which have exceeded their useful life; and

WHEREAS, this purchase requires approval of a Capital Asset; and

WHEREAS, the Transit Services Division has received FTA 5311 CRRSAA capital funding in the amount of \$452,890; and

WHEREAS, the Transit Services Division has sufficient capital asset expense budget available in the FY2023-24 budget 4281-91003-707-2000 / 540500; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors does hereby:

1. Authorizes the County of Nevada Purchasing Agent to purchase Capital Assets of two (2) ADA accessible Class B – 12 passenger cutaway buses from Model 1 Commercial Vehicles via the CalAct/MBTA Cooperative Agreement No. 20-01.
