OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO SIGN THE INVITATION TO BID, AND THE PURCHASING AGENT TO SOLICIT BIDS, FOR THE 2026 ROAD REHABILITATION PROJECT, COUNTY PROJECT NUMBER 450014 - DISTRICTS I, II, V

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works desires to maintain approximately 28 miles of County maintained roadways as routine maintenance and safety measures; and

WHEREAS, under section 15301(c) of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines, Class 1 projects consisting of the maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public facilities, are categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act; and

WHEREAS, bidding documents have been prepared to accomplish this work; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works may make adjustments to the roadways listed as necessary; and

WHEREAS, the county-maintained road sections of this project will be funded by the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Act (RMRA), and the non-county maintained road sections of PRD Darkhorse and CSA 12 Zone 1 Adamson Road will be funded by Fund 3437 and Fund 3252 respectively; and

WHEREAS, Road Engineering, PRD Darkhorse, and CSA 12 Zone 1 Adamson Road budgets will be appropriated as needed upon contract execution; and

WHEREAS, the project specifications and cost estimate for this project have all been completed. The Engineer's estimate is \$2,650,000, plus a 10% contingency of \$265,000 for a total not to exceed contract of \$2,915,000; and

WHEREAS, construction is scheduled to begin in July 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors:

1. Authorizes the Public Works Department to proceed with 2026 Road Rehabilitation Project under a categorical exemption from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.
2. Authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to sign the Invitation to Bid.
3. Authorizes the Purchasing Agent to solicit bids for the 2026 Road Rehabilitation Project.
4. Authorizes the Public Works Director to incorporate any final changes into the bid documents before advertising for bids.
