OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING A RENEWAL CONTRACT WITH PROGRESS HOUSE, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF PERINATAL AND NON-PERINATAL COMPREHENSIVE RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT PROGRAM SERVICES INCLUDING WITHDRAWAL MANAGEMENT FOR THE RECOVERY OF SUBSTANCE USE DISORDERS TO RESIDENTS OF NEVADA COUNTY IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$1,000,000 FOR THE CONTRACT TERM OF JULY 1, 2026 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2027

WHEREAS, Progress House Inc. is a non-profit organization licensed by the State to provide services for the prevention, treatment, and recovery of substance use disorders; and

WHEREAS, Progress House Inc. provides Perinatal and Non-Perinatal services for substance using pregnant and/or parenting women and men; Comprehensive Residential Treatment Program Services for the recovery of substance use disorders; and

WHEREAS, under this agreement the Progress House will provide comprehensive Residential Treatment Program services for adults, including 24 hours/7 days per week supervision, residential, and withdrawal management services, at various Progress House, Inc. operated facilities for County clients.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Professional Services Contract by and between the County and Progress House, Inc. pertaining to the provision of Perinatal and Non-Perinatal services for substance using pregnant and/or parenting women and men; Comprehensive Residential Treatment Program Services for the recovery of substance use disorders to residents of Nevada County for the contract term of July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027, in the maximum amount of \$1,000,000 be and hereby is approved, and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the County of Nevada. This contract is contingent upon the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2026/27 County Budget. The contract begins on July 1, 2026.
