



RESOLUTION No. 25-502

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH BE CHANGE LLC, DBA NIMBL VEHICLES TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY VEHICLE EQUIPMENT AND INSTALLATION SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$50,000 FOR THE CONTRACT TERM OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2025, TO JUNE 30, 2026, AND INCLUDES THE OPTION TO EXTEND THE CONTRACT FOR ONE YEAR

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has a current and future need for vehicles to be outfitted with emergency and specialty equipment; and

WHEREAS, Be Change LLC, dba Nimbl Vehicles, has provided equipment purchase and installation services for Sheriff's Office vehicles in the past and has the requisite experience; and

WHEREAS, the County of Nevada desires to enter a professional services contract with Be Change LLC, dba Nimbl Vehicles to provide equipment purchase and installation services for Sheriff's Office vehicles with a contract commencing on September 1, 2025, to June 30, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors, of County of Nevada, State of California, that the professional services contract between the County of Nevada and Be Change LLC, dba Nimbl Vehicles, pertaining to the purchase and installation of emergency equipment on Sheriff's Office vehicles, in the amount of \$50,000 for the contract term of September 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026, and including an option to extend the contract by one year, is hereby approved, and the Chair of the Board of Supervisors is authorized to execute the contract on behalf of the County of Nevada.
