OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF A RENEWAL CONTRACT WITH TURNING POINT COMMUNITY PROGRAMS, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES ACT (BHSA) ADULT ASSERTIVE COMMUNITY TREATMENT (AACT) PROGRAM SERVICES AND INTEGRATED HEALTH CARE SERVICES AS PART OF THE INTEGRATION SERVICES TEAM (IST) IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$6,277,012 FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2026, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2027

WHEREAS, Turning Point Community Programs, Inc. will continue to provide Adult Full Service Partnership (FSP) services within the Nevada County Behavioral Health System of Care, in alignment with the Behavioral Health Services Act (BHSA) Community Services and Supports (CSS) Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor's AACT Team model is a multi-disciplinary approach to providing community-based treatment, outreach, rehabilitation, and support services to individuals with serious mental illness, and the Team operates 24-hours, 365 days a year to provide flexible crisis intervention and wraparound services that are tailored to address each eligible participant's unique and changing needs; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor will continue to implement and monitor a Supportive Independent Living Program for Medi-Cal beneficiaries that serves a critical ongoing need for providing safe, supported housing in the least restrictive environment for appropriate clients; and

WHEREAS, the vision of Nevada County Behavioral Health is to build and support healthy futures in which people with a serious mental illness are able to achieve health, wellness, and recovery through the development of integrated health care services and identification of a person-centered health care home; and

WHEREAS, Contractor will continue to operate the peer-led Insight Respite Center facility as an alternative to inpatient hospitalization for individuals experiencing a mental health crisis; and

WHEREAS, Contractor will implement an Individual Placement and Supports model of supported employment to help clients obtain competitive work in the community and provide them with the necessary support to ensure their success in the workplace.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Professional Services Contract by and between the County and Turning Point Community Programs, Inc. pertaining to the provision of Adult Assertive Community Treatment Program Services as a component of the County's Behavioral Health Services Act Community Services and Supports Plan; Supported Independent Living Program Services; and peer-led Insight Respite Center services for the term of July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027 in the maximum amount of \$6,277,012 be and hereby is approved, and that

the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute the Contract on behalf of the County of Nevada.
