



# RESOLUTION No. 23-219

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

### RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CAPITAL ASSET PURCHASE OF FOUR SPECIALIZED ALL TERRAIN ELECTRIC BIKES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$21,650 AND AMENDING THE FY 22/23 OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES BUDGET (4/5 AFFIRMATIVE VOTE REQUIRED)

WHEREAS, one of the current Nevada County Board Objectives is to “Lead the community in all hazards planning, preparedness, response, and recovery with a focus on wildfire.”; and

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, the President of the United States signed into law the American Rescue Plan Act (“ARPA”), which included 363 billion in federal fiscal recovery aid to state and local governments (State and Local Aid), including \$65.1 billion direct aid to counties; and

WHEREAS, on April 27, 2021 the Board of Supervisors was presented with information and provided guidance on the county ARPA Expenditure Plan for local county funds anticipated to be received through ARPA; and

WHEREAS, on October 11, 2021, the Board of Supervisors passed and adopted Resolution 22-095, accepting the funding award from the ARPA State and Local Aid program in the amount of \$60,739; U.S Department of Homeland Security is funding a grant through the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services to assist state, local , and tribal governments to enhance their capability to prevent, prepare for, mitigate against, respond to, and recover from emergencies and disasters, whether natural or man-made; The deadline to obligate all funds is June 30, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Office of Emergency Services plan for ARPA funds includes four all-terrain electrical bikes; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of four specialized electrical bikes by the Office of Emergency Services will support the Nevada County Sheriff's Search and Rescue Team with an all-terrain asset to use in non-motorized areas; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Emergency Services will purchase three specialized all terrain bikes in the amount of \$21,650 and is funded from the American Rescue Plan Act funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, authorizes:

1. Approves the allocation of ARPA funds in the amount of \$21,650 to the Office of Emergency Services for the purchase of four capital assets.
2. The purchase of three capital asset Specialized All Terrain Electrical Bikes in the amount of \$21,650 and authorize County Purchasing to encumber these funds and issue purchase order.

3. Directs the Auditor-Controller to amend the Fiscal Year 2022/23 Office of Emergency Services budget as follows:
