

#### Overdose Deaths Involving Opioids, by Type of Opioid, United States, 2000-2016



There have been previous overdose epidemics but not nearly as big: 2016 rose to over 63,000 deaths with the sharpest increase related to fentanyl

#### Unintentional Drug Overdose Deaths United States, 1970–2007






### Heroin use is part of a larger substance abuse problem.

Nearly all people who used heroin also used at least 1 other drug.

Most used at least 3 other drugs.

Heroin is a highly addictive opioid drug with a high risk of overdose and death for users.

People who are addicted to...




...more likely to be addicted to heroin.





- Opioids are safe and effective for chronic pain.







## Some states have more opioid prescriptions per person than others.





### Public Health Impact of Opioid Use


- In 2010, for every 1 overdose death...
  - 10 Treatment admissions for substance use
  - ■26 ED visits for misuse or abuse
  - 108 people with abuse/dependence
  - ■733 non-medical users in the past year
