Department of Social Services

Nevada County Eligibility and Employment workers tirelessly help the citizens of Nevada County with a wide array of services. They administer public assistance programs that reduce food insecurity, strengthen health outcomes, provide safety and security, and develop valuable workplace skills to support our local families and assist with the journey to self-sufficiency.

INCREASED NEED

In the past four years our:

- CalFresh caseload has grown by 43%
- Medi-Cal caseload has grown by 16%
- CalWORKs caseload has grown by 17%
- General Assistance caseload has grown over 100%

OVER THE LAST YEAR

This past year Eligibility and Employment programs have provided the following to our community:

PROVIDED 1,114 EMERGENCY FOOD BAGS TO CUSTOMERS IN WESTERN AND EASTERN COUNTY

PROVIDED 15,471 INDIVIDUALS WITH CALFRESH OR FOOD BENEFITS.

SUPPORTED 65 FAMILIES WITH PERMANENT HOUSING AND 43 WITH TRANSITIONAL HOUSING.

PROVIDED 30,819 INDIVIDUALS WITH HEALTH CARE COVERAGE THROUGH MEDI-CAL.

PLACED 40 PARTICIPANTS IN SUBSIDIZED EMPLOYMENT POSITIONS WITH BUSINESSES AND NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS.

ISSUED OVER \$39,693,021 OF FEDERAL AND STATE FUNDS THAT WERE SPENT IN OUR COMMUNITY SUPPORTING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.
