**SUBJECT:** Resolution authorizing the Airport Manager to submit an application for a Federal Aviation Administration Grant in the amount of \$115,157 to fund the design of the Taxiway A, Ramps 1, 2, and 5 Pavement Preservation and Service Road Paving at the Nevada County Airport and authorizing the Chief Information Officer to execute the application.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Adopt the Resolution

**FUNDING:** The total cost of the design of the Taxiway A, Ramps 1, 2, and 5 Pavement Preservation and Service Road Paving is estimated at \$127,952. The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) is expected to fund 90% of the cost, or \$115,157 and CALTRANS Division of Aeronautics is expected to fund 4.5% of the cost, or \$5,758. The remaining 5.5% of the cost, or \$7,037, will be funded by the Airport Enterprise Fund. There is no impact to the General Fund.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Nevada County Airport is responsible for effectively maintaining paved surfaces at the Airport in compliance with Federal Aviation Administration Airport Sponsor Grant Assurance #11. In order for the pavement to be properly preserved, rehabilitated, or otherwise constructed, the project must undergo an engineering design phase. The Nevada County Airport Commission endorsed the grant application at a Special Airport Commission meeting held on November 28th, 2016. This resolution will enable the airport to apply for a Federal Aviation Administration grant to complete the design of the Taxiway A, Ramps 1, 2, and 5 Pavement Preservation and Service Road Paving project. We are also requesting that the Chief Information Officer be authorized to execute this application and any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining financial assistance provided by this FAA Grant.
