BACKGROUND:

Currently, there are seven vacancies on the Adult and Family Services Commission. Two Public Sector and two Private Sector vacancies for unexpired two-year terms ending April 30, 2025. One Private Sector, one Public Sector, and one Low-Income Sector vacancies for unexpired two-year terms ending April 30, 2026. These vacancies were advertised and posted for a minimum of ten days at the following places: the Board of Supervisors Chambers bulletin board, the Board of Supervisors office, and the County website. Notice was also posted at the Truckee Town Hall and the District V Board of Supervisors office in Truckee.

Louise Reed submitted an application for appointment to the Commission on June 4, 2024. At the Adult and Family Services Commission meeting on June 11, 2024, the commission recommended Louise for appointment as Low-Income Sector representative.
