



The total dollar value of all agricultural products grown within Nevada County during the 2023 calendar year.






On September 18th, 2024,

# Sustainable Agricultural Activities Department Highlights

- 6,300 packages and shipments inspected for live exotic pests
- 466 insect traps placed and inspected for live exotic pests
- 850+ sites surveyed and treated for noxious and invasive weeds
- Issued 244 pesticide permits
- Issued 22 Certified Producers Certificates, 6 Certified Farmers Markets, registered 31 organic producers
- 1,357 weighing and measuring devices tested for accuracy
