## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

### RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE 2025 DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE AWARD OF THE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES (COPS) MICROGRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$175,000 FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN MX908 DEVICE AND PARTIAL FUNDING OF THE PEREGRINE SOFTWARE SOLUTION AND AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF TO EXECUTE THE AWARD

WHEREAS, the US Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS), offers a grant program known as the Microgrant; and


WHEREAS, the Nevada County Sheriff's Office has received notice that the 2025 COPS Microgrant has been awarded to the Nevada County Sheriff's Office in the amount of \$175,000 and will be used for the purchase of a MX908 device (a device that identifies unknown substances in the field) and fund year two of Peregrine Software Solutions contract; and

WHEREAS, the project period is from October 1, 2025 to September 30, 2027, during which time the Sheriff's Office expects to receive and expend the funds in County fiscal years 2025/26 and 2026/27.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors:

1. Accepts the COPS Microgrant funding, in the amount of \$175,000, from the Department of Justice Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (the COPS Office), to purchase a MX908 device and to fund year two of the Peregrine Software Solutions contract; and
2. Authorizes the Sheriff to sign the Award Documents and certifications.


