#### **BACKGROUND:**

After nearly 28 years of service in the Town of Truckee, Dan Wilkins announced his retirement, effective June 2025. Dan will continue to support the Town through the end of 2025 to ensure a seamless transition with his replacement.

Dan was initially hired by the Town of Truckee in January 1998 as an Associate Town Engineer. After quickly moving through the ranks, Dan became the Director of Public Works and Town Engineer in 2001.

Dan's accomplishments are numerous and have shaped the Town of Truckee, becoming essential parts of daily life for residents and visitors alike. Dan was responsible for the implementation of 13 roundabouts, including the first multilane roundabouts on a Caltrans facility in Northern California at the Highway 89/I-80 interchange, along with more than 25 miles of paved trails, 8 miles of sidewalk, bike lanes on over 30 miles of roadway, and two new railroad crossings: the SR 89 Mousehole and the McIver Undercrossing.

Dan grew up in Vermont and graduated from the University of Vermont with a BA in civil engineering. His path brought him to the Truckee-Tahoe region in the 1990's and he has dedicated his career here to improving the infrastructure for the benefit of residents and visitors alike. Dan's engineering excellence coupled with his thoughtful vision of the future have been instrumental in shaping the Town of Truckee through its

growth over the last 30 years. Without Dan, the Town of Truckee would not be what it is today.
