OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A REVISED CONSOLIDATED USER FEE SCHEDULE FOR COUNTY DEPARTMENTS AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION 25-318 AS AMENDED

WHEREAS, the County of Nevada is required to provide certain services for which it is appropriate to charge a fee; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada (“the Board”) has the authority to establish fees that do not exceed the reasonable cost of providing the service or regulatory activity for which the fee is charged; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires that departments be financially self-supporting to an extent that balances cost recovery with accessibility to services; and

WHEREAS, in order to develop a user fee schedule that is fair, equitable, and accessible to the recipients of services and to County taxpayers, the Board, at its 2015 Board Workshop, directed the establishment of the User Fee Review Group (“UFRG”), consisting of representatives from County Counsel, Auditor-Controller and County Executive offices; and

WHEREAS, the UFRG is tasked with reviewing fee studies and proposals for reasonableness and making recommendations to the Board for the adoption of fee schedules that are both justifiable within the confines of applicable government codes and provide for accessibility to services where appropriate; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 19-242 approved the introduction of an adjustment where appropriate to certain fees by Consumer Price Index for urban wage earners and clerical workers in the State of California (CPI); and

WHEREAS, Resolution 25-318 approved the current Consolidated User Fee Schedule for County Departments; and

WHEREAS, the fees set forth in the attached fee schedules are recommended by the UFRG to the Board for adoption as reasonable, equitable and accessible and not more than the costs of providing the service for which the fee is imposed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Nevada County Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California:

1. The Board reaffirms its intent for the User Fee Review Group (UFRG) to:
 - a. Review all user fee schedules for compliance with the standard that proposed fees do not exceed the reasonable cost of providing the service or regulatory activity for which the fee is charged
 - b. Make determinations regarding the fiscal sustainability and material impact of softening certain fees for the purpose of service accessibility
 - c. Make recommendations to the Board for approval of said fee schedules

2. The UFRG is authorized to administratively adjust or add mandatory State-adopted fees to the attached fee schedules if the County is required to collect such fees on behalf of or at the express direction of the State.
3. Fees indicated in the attached fee schedules can be automatically adjusted annually for up to five fiscal years following the most recent fee study update, where appropriate. Such annual adjustment shall be the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for urban wage earners and clerical workers in the State of California for the previous twelve months ending in December as published by the State of California Department of Industrial Relations. Annual adjustments shall only be made if the CPI is more than zero percent and does not result in a fee that exceeds the reasonable cost of providing the service. The County shall apply, and post notice of all automatic fee increases at least sixty days prior to the effective date of the increase, for which the effective date would be no sooner than July 1 of each fiscal year.
4. The following Community Development Agency Department Fees shall have additional phased increases in addition to CPI as follows (as originally authorized in resolution 24-298):
 - a. Cannabis Compliance: 3.5% for FY 26/27
 - b. Code Compliance: 2.82% for FY 26/27
5. The UFRG shall annually review the attached fee schedules to confirm that the application of the CPI is consistent with the County's local cost increases and the County's actual cost of providing the identified services. If there is a substantial deviation from CPI and actual costs, the User Fee Review Group will recommend to the Board of Supervisors an amended fee schedule.
6. This resolution and all fee schedules attached hereto shall be effective sixty (60) days after its adoption.
7. Resolution 25-318 is rescinded upon the effective date of this resolution.
8. The attached Consolidated User Fee Schedule is hereby established and adopted.
