The purpose of this Commission is to promote, support, and improve the early development of children from the prenatal stage to five (5) years of age, through the establishment, institution and coordination of appropriate standards (strategic plan), resources and integrated and comprehensive programs emphasizing community awareness, education, nurturing, child care, social services, health care and research. This Commission was created and established pursuant to the authority granted under the California Children and Families First Act of 1998 (Proposition 10) adopted by voters on November 3, 1998.

Appointed members shall serve for two-year terms at the will and pleasure of the board of Supervisors. The member from the Behavioral Health, Public Health or Social Services Department Head position shall be selected by the County Executive Officer and appointed by the Board of Supervisors.

The Commission shall hold monthly meetings, except in March, July, and November, and shall hold at least two meetings per year in Truckee.
