### **OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA**

#### **RESOLUTION APPROVING RENEWAL OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY - DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES AND THE NEVADA COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF TITLE IV-E FUNDS TO COORDINATE EDUCATIONAL SUPPORT SERVICES FOR NEVADA COUNTY FOSTER YOUTH, IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$237,960 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026/27**

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Superintendent of Schools (NCSOS) operates the Foster Youth Coordinating Program (FYSCP) and is responsible for providing foster youth with educational services in accordance with sections 42920 through 42926 of the California Education Code; and

WHEREAS, the passage of Assembly Bill 854 in October 2015 further clarified the requirements of operating an FYSCP, including a requirement to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with a local child welfare department for the purpose of drawing down Title IV-E funds for eligible case management activities to support FYSCP; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Social Services (DSS) and FYSPC have a similar mission, and a collaboration was established for serving foster youth in Nevada County, with the intention that all Nevada County foster youth shall receive support for educational opportunities; and

WHEREAS, DSS shall provide reimbursement of Title IV-E funds for the FYSCP, up to the amount of \$237,960; and

WHEREAS, DSS and the NCSOS desire to enter into an MOU whereby DSS shall provide Title IV-E reimbursement to enhance educational support services and information sharing for Nevada County foster youth through the FYSCP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the MOU by and between DSS and NCSOS pertaining to the provision of educational support services for foster youth for the term of July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, in the maximum amount of \$237,960, be and hereby is approved in substantially the form attached hereto and that the Director of DSS is authorized to execute the MOU on behalf of the County. This contract is contingent upon the adoption of the FY 26/27 County Budget. The contract begins on July 1, 2026.
