OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING AUGUST 2026 AS “CHILD SUPPORT AWARENESS MONTH” IN NEVADA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, Nevada County’s children have a right to receive emotional and financial support from both of their parents; and

WHEREAS, Sierra Nevada Regional Department of Child Support Services (“SNRDCSS”) recognizes that financial support is just one piece of a broader effort to empower families and promote positive co-parenting relationships; and

WHEREAS, SNRDCSS remains dedicated to helping both parents meet their responsibilities in ways that are realistic, achievable, and in the best interest of the child; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County’s program embraces a modernized vision of service that removes barriers, reduces uncollectable debt, and supports long-term family self-sufficiency; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County is recognized as a leader in child support program performance, consistently exceeding statewide averages across all federal performance measures, thereby contributing to increased financial security and stability for the County’s children and their families; and

WHEREAS, Child Support Awareness Month serves as a call to action for Nevada County, affirming that every family, regardless of structure or circumstance, deserves the opportunity to provide stability and support for their children.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, proclaim the month of August 2026 to be “Child Support Awareness Month” in Nevada County.
