 United Way of Nevada County's mission is to improve lives of community members by directing community resources to local needs.

 We strive to assure that individuals and families in Nevada County meet their basic need for food and access to healthcare.






- United Way of Nevada County currently has 19 partner organizations as part of its partner network.
- The organization collaborates with its partners to fill gaps in services to the community.
- Through these collaborative efforts, programs have been developed to provide services to those in need.





- 1) United Way collaborated with California CareForce to bring the Free Health Clinic to Grass Valley in July 2022.
- 613 patients were served over a two-day period
- 2,686 Medical, Dental and Vision services were provided
- We intend to bring the clinic back in 2024







- 2) UWNC has continued and expanded its partnership with Interfaith Food Ministry (IFM) for Food Access Saturday (FAS).
- As of August of this year, 14,263 bags of food have been distributed to 6090 individuals since the program's inception in 2017.
- As of September, food-insecure individuals and families can get bags of nutritious food every Saturday.







- 3) The High School Food Pantry Program, a collaboration with IFM and school officials, is now the School Pantry Program.
- Since its inception in September 2020, this program has provided over 500 bags of food to students and their families.
- In addition to all area high schools, the School Pantry Program is also available at Williams Ranch Elementary, Arete Charter Academy and Ready Springs Elementary School.





- Project Warmth Each year UWNC collects and distributes coats, gloves, socks and hats for those in need.
 - This year's goal is to increase collection boxes by 20%
- Single Care Through United Way's program, we offer a prescription discount without regard to insurance status.
 - Since the inception of this program, we have helped 6,144 Nevada County residents save \$888,677.





2022-2023 Partner Network

- United Way's partner agencies are doing great work for our community.
- We will be highlighting six of them throughout the County campaign.

















1) Bright Futures For Youth

- Created by the merger of The Friendship Club and NEO in summer 2020, this organization's programs address issues and help specifically to the youth of our community.
- Its focus areas are health and wellness, healthy relationships, goal setting, self-awareness, self-sufficiency and community connectedness..





2) Food Bank of Nevada County

- Established in 1986 to alleviate hunger and food insecurity in Nevada County.
- FBNC provides food distribution throughout Nevada County to all residents in need of services.





3) Gold Country Senior Services

- Provides essential programs that meet the basic needs of seniors living in Western Nevada County.
- GCCS ensures older adults have nutritional meals, warm homes, social interaction and a greater sense of security.





4) FREED

• Promotes independence and self-determination for people with disabilities through direct services, community partnerships, and leadership that advocates for fully inclusive communities.





5) Sierra Roots

- Dedicated to listening to homeless people and collaborating with them to make progress in their health, self-reliance, and action plans for secure, safe homes.
- Recently, they have partnered with Nevada County's HOME Team, Hospitality House, and other nonprofits to better serve homeless people in western Nevada County.





6) PiELL

- Partners in English Language Learning teaches English language learners in our community with trained volunteer tutors.
- Each participant is assigned a personal tutor based on the learner's specific needs.
