**SUBJECT:** Resolution approving execution of Amendment 2 to the Contract with

Bright Futures for Youth for Friday Night Live/Club Live Pilot Project to increase the maximum contract price from \$174,999.96 to \$199,999.96 (an increase of \$25,000), revise Exhibit "A", Schedule of Services to expand the number of programs implemented through FY24/25, reflect an

additional funding source and revise Exhibit "B", Schedule of Charges and

Payments to reflect the increase in the maximum contract price.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached Resolution.

<u>FUNDING</u>: The contract is a three-year Pilot Project to support the expansion of Friday Night Live, Club Live and Friday Night Live Kids programming in Nevada County schools. Services will be supported by Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 (CRRSAA), American Recovery Plan Act (ARPA) funds and Alcohol and Other Drug Prevention Fund 1146 and are within the department's budget. Services are discretionary and the funding source is through Federal funds (Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration) passed through the state Department of Health Care Services, as well as local funds raised from alcohol abuse education and prevention penalty assessments collected pursuant to Vehicle Code section 23645 as outlined in Penal Code Section 1463.25. There are no County general funds required for this contract amendment.

**BACKGROUND:** On October 18, 2022, per Purchasing Order PESQ4601, the Nevada County Purchasing Agent approved execution of the Professional Services Contract with Bright Futures for Youth for Friday Night Live/Club Live Pilot Project which was subsequently amended on December 13, 2022 per Resolution 22-633.

The County-wide Friday Night Live/Club Live (FNL/CL) program is primarily focused on forming youth-adult partnerships with young people to provide programs rich in opportunities and support, so young people will be less likely to engage in problem behaviors, more likely to achieve in

school, and more likely to attend higher education or secure employment. FNL/CL's vision is to work hand-in-hand with young people, so they are both problem free and fully prepared. School advisors lead the clubs with support from county staff and community partners. FNL/CL has been active in Nevada County for 28 years.

The Friday Night Live/Club Live Pilot Project's goal is to expand alcohol and other drug prevention services and youth leadership development opportunities for students in Nevada County schools through additional Friday Night Live (high school), Club Live (middle school) and Friday Night Live Kids (elementary school) programming. The Pilot Project began in August of 2022 and already has resulted in the expansion of these youth leadership development programs to six new sites with more sites planned in the future. The amendment increases the maximum amount of the contract by \$12,500 per fiscal year in FY23/24 and 24/25 and expands the scope of work to include additional new chapters. Both Public Health and Bright Futures for Youth are excited to expand the Pilot Project.

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors approves this amendment as it provides alcohol and other drug prevention services and youth leadership development opportunities that can help safeguard the health and wellbeing of youth in Nevada County.
