

- First-time participant in The NCS
- Scientific sample of 1,800 households
 - 545 returned surveys; 32% response rate
 - ±4% margin of error




2017 Benchmark Comparisons

- * Most important











Quality





Aspects of Safety

At least 8 in 10 positively rated:




- Safe neighborhoods (97%)
- Safe downtown/commercial areas (92%)
- Fire prevention (82%)
- Overall feeling of safety (81%)
- Sheriff (80%)

Other Safety Issues

At least:

8 in 10

- Had concerns about homelessness regarding:
 - Illegal camping
 - Loitering/nuisance in business areas
 - Public safety




- Were concerned with illegal campfires, illegal encampments or forest health
- Felt there were fiscal barriers to making their property wildfire safe
