**RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 4 TO THE
CONTRACT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF NEVADA AND
DOKKEN ENGINEERING, INC., FOR PROFESSIONAL
ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE SOUTH YUBA RIVER
AT NORTH BLOOMFIELD ROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT
PROJECT, BRLO-5917 (078) TO EXTEND CONTRACT TERM
TO DECEMBER 31, 2027 - DISTRICTS I, IV, V**

WHEREAS, the County of Nevada entered into a contract with Dokken Engineering, Inc. on December 2, 2014, by Resolution 14-529 for a contract totaling \$635,045.59 for professional engineering services for the South Yuba River at North Bloomfield Road Bridge Replacement Project, with a contract term ending on December 17, 2019; and

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2019, the Board of Supervisors approved Resolution 19-641 for Amendment No. 1 extending the contract length by 5 years to conclude on December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, on October 25, 2022, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 22-550 for Amendment No. 2 to modify the scope of work from a bridge rehabilitation project to include environmental services associated with the bridge replacement project; and

WHEREAS, on October 22, 2024, the Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution 25-550 for Amendment No. 3 to increase the contract value by \$124,167.23 and extend the contract length to a date of December 31, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works is recommending Amendment No. 4 to the contract to extend the contract end date from December 31, 2025, to December 31, 2027, see attached Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, in all other respects the prior agreement of the parties shall remain in full force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors:

1. Approves Amendment No. 4, attached hereto, to the professional services contract by and between the County of Nevada and Dokken Engineering, Inc. and extends the contract end date from December 31, 2025, to December 31, 2027.
2. Authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute Amendment No. 4.
