WHEREAS, the CHILDREN'S BILL OF RIGHTS FOR NEVADA COUNTY, is a public declaration of support for the rights of children and youth to fundamental elements of their health, safety, well-being and quality of life; and

WHEREAS, the Community Support Network of Nevada County, a collaborative of family-service agencies, has created this Bill of Rights with input from community members of all ages; and

WHEREAS, this declaration represents support for all children and youth to:

> feel safe in homes, schools, neighborhoods, and communities;

- basic essentials including nutritious food, housing, clothing, and transportation;
- > accessible, coordinated, and timely physical, dental, and mental health care;
- > supportive, nurturing relationships with adults in their lives;

> a healthy environment, including clean air and water;


be respected and valued as individuals;

high quality child care and educational settings from birth through independence;

> a voice in matters that may affect them; and

> DREAM BIG, to be challenged, and to live their lives with hope and inspiration.
