SUBJECT: Resolution approving a one-year contract with up to four (4) contract renewals with Robinson Enterprises, Inc. for Leachate Transport Services at the McCourtney Road Closed Landfill for an amount not to exceed \$450,000, contingent upon adoption of the Fiscal Year 2026/27 County Budget and authorizing the Purchasing Agent to execute the contract and renewals (District IV)

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached resolution.

FUNDING: Funding is for Fiscal Year 2026/27 and impacts the Solid Waste budget, contingent upon adoption of the Fiscal Year 2026/27 County budget. Funding is provided by parcel charge assessment, and no budget amendment is needed. There is no impact on the General Fund.

BACKGROUND: On June 17, 2017, Nevada County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 17-322 awarding a contract to Robinson Enterprises, Inc. for leachate transport services at the McCourtney Road Closed Landfill on an “as needed” basis. Leachate is a byproduct of buried trash. Leachate is collected and stored in containment tanks with a maximum capacity of 180,000 gallons and there is a continual need for leachate transport services at the closed landfill.

Robinson Enterprises is the sole source vendor as they are the only local provider that can provide these services with the required equipment. Any out of the area providers cannot meet the competitive prices offered by Robinson Enterprises.

Staff is recommending approval of this contract in an amount not to exceed \$450,000 for a contract term of July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, with up to four (4) one year term contract renewals.
