RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENT NUMBER 2 TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF NEVADA AND PARATRANSIT SERVICES FOR THE PROVISION OF SPECIALIZED PARATRANSIT SERVICES IN WESTERN NEVADA COUNTY AND AUTHORIZING THE CHAIR OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE THE AMENDMENT ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

WHEREAS, on May 14, 2013, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 13-168, approving a five-year contract with Paratransit Services for provision of specialized Paratransit Services in western Nevada County that began on July 1, 2013 and will expire on June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, on July 22, 2014, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 14-362 approving an amendment to the contract between Nevada County and Paratransit Services; and


WHEREAS, the contract agreement contains a provision for an annual increase of the Paratransit Services contract price that includes both a fixed vehicle service hourly rate and a fixed monthly rate on July 1st of each contract year equivalent to the increase in the CPI (California Consumer Price Index, California Department of Industrial Relations, Division of Labor Research, All Urban Consumers) for the most recent available twelve month period prior to each scheduled increase in an amount of not less than one percent (1%), with a cap of three percent (3%) annually; and

WHEREAS, the California CPI calculation for the twelve month period of April 2014 through April 2015 reports a 1.1 percent increase; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County and Paratransit Services wish to amend the contract agreement to include an increase of the Paratransit Services' fixed vehicle service hourly rate to \$35.10 and the fixed monthly rate to \$55,728 per the applicable annual CPI effective July 1, 2015 through Fiscal Year 2015/16.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Approves the attached Amendment to increase the Paratransit Services' fixed vehicle service hourly rate to \$35.10 and the fixed monthly rate to \$55,728 through Fiscal Year 2015/16.
- 2. Authorizes the Chair of the Board of Supervisors to execute on behalf of Nevada County the amendment between Nevada County and Paratransit Services.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

PARATRANSIT SERVICES CONTRACT

THIS AMENDMENT is executed this <u>25thday</u> of <u>August</u>, 2015, by and between PARATRANSIT SERVICES and COUNTY OF NEVADA. Said Amendment will amend the prior agreement between the parties entitled Personal Services Contract between County of Nevada and Paratransit Services for Provision of Specialized Paratransit Services in western Nevada County, executed on July 1, 2013, by Resolution No. 13-168 and which agreement was subsequently amended on July 22, 2014, by Resolution Number 14-362.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Exhibit "B" of the Personal Services Contract, increase the Paratransit Services' fixed vehicle service hourly rate to \$35.10 and the fixed monthly rate to \$55,728 effective July 1, 2015 through Fiscal Year 2015/16.
- 2. That in all other respects the prior agreement of the parties shall remain in full force and effect except as amended herein.
