


Helping Nevada County youth to thrive since 2008.

Why NEO Got Started

Teens:

- Were unsupervised & unengaged
- Engaging in high risk behaviors
- Lacking an appropriate place to socialize
- Wanted their voices to be heard
- Wanted responsibility & leadership roles



We wanted to be proactive & address community concerns

- 1. To reduce youth isolation
- 2. Help youth develop a sense of purpose
- 3. Help youth build self-esteem & skills for success
- 4. Empower youth to make healthy lifestyle choices


