RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING THE MONTH OF APRIL 2026 AS ARTS, CULTURE, AND CREATIVITY MONTH IN NEVADA COUNTY

WHEREAS, Arts, Culture, and Creativity Month, celebrated each April, is the eighth annual statewide observance established by the California Legislature in 2019; and

WHEREAS, Nevada County is the home of two of California's 14 state-designated cultural districts including the Truckee Cultural District and the Grass Valley-Nevada City (GVNC) Cultural District; and

WHEREAS, the County of Nevada believes that arts, culture, and creativity are essential to a thriving community and inspire joy and connection; and

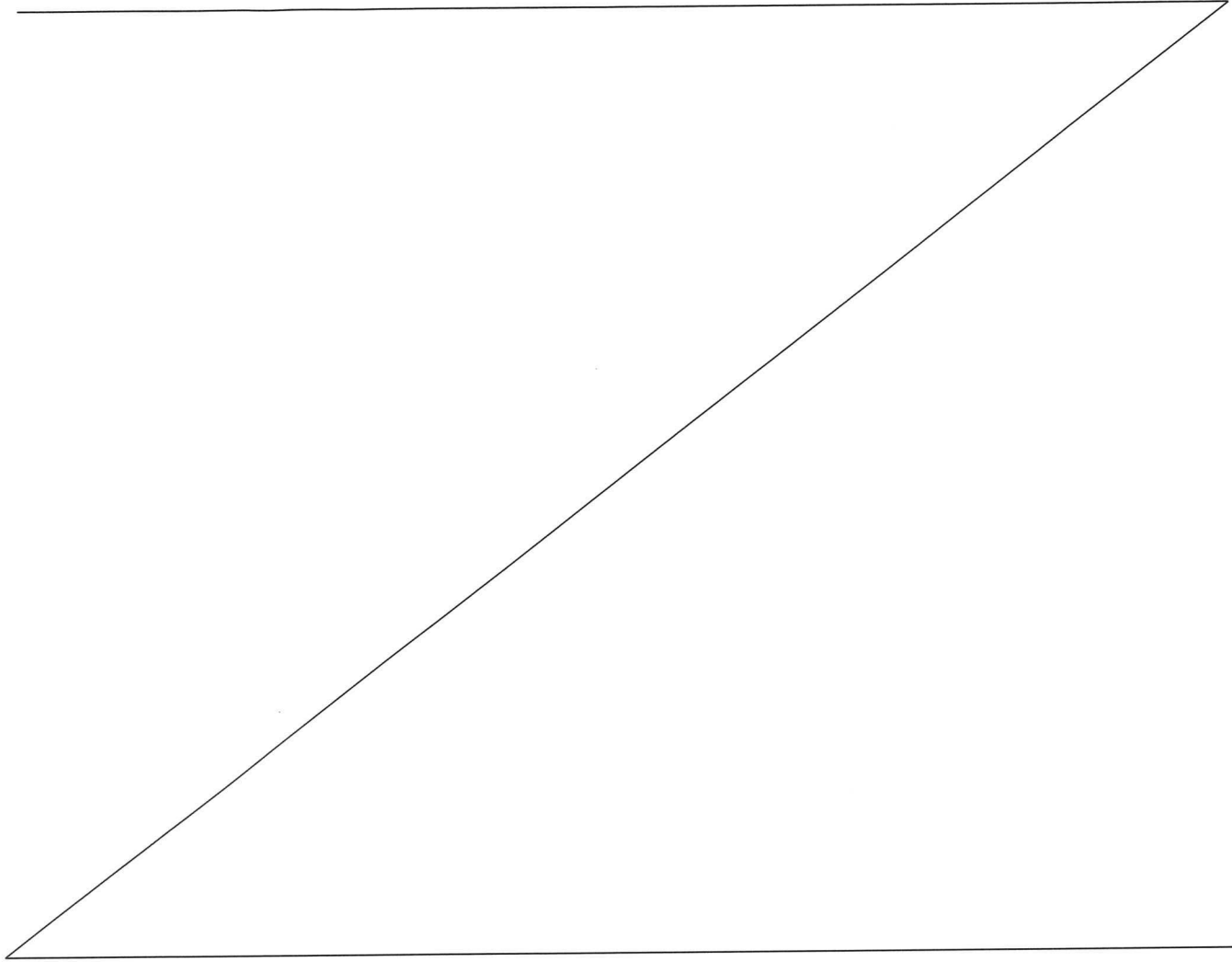
WHEREAS, the County of Nevada believes that the arts are a vital part of a rural economy, creating meaningful work for artists while generating a broader downstream of benefits for the community; and

WHEREAS, the creative sector contributes approximately \$66 million and nearly 1,400 full-time equivalent jobs to Nevada County's economy annually, according to the 2022-23 Arts and Economic Prosperity Study of Nevada County; and

WHEREAS, the County of Nevada helps to advance the arts through programs such as Art in Public Spaces; and

WHEREAS, the County of Nevada values its partnership with Nevada County Arts Council and state-level arts organizations such as California for the Arts and California Arts Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors, of Nevada County, hereby proclaims the month of April 2026 as Arts, Culture, and Creativity Month in Nevada County.
