SUBJECT: Resolution to ratify a Proclamation of a Local Emergency in Nevada County Due to Extreme Weather and to request the Governor to proclaim a State of Emergency for Nevada County, to authorize the CEO to take action for necessary repair of public facilities, and to authorize a registered Engineer under the direction of the Department of Public Works to make necessary repairs to County Roads.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the Resolution

FUNDING: The potential fiscal impact is unknown at this time. The California Disaster Assistance Act may fund up to 75 percent of eligible response and recovery costs.

BACKGROUND: Steve Monaghan, the Director of Emergency Services, declared a local emergency on February 22, 2017 as a result of extreme weather from which resulted in wide spread damage throughout Nevada County. In accordance with the California Emergency Services Act Section 8630(b) the governing body must ratify the declared emergency within 7 days for it to remain in effect.

Additionally, the Director of Emergency Services must submit a request to the Board requesting the Governor to proclaim a State of Emergency for Nevada County and authorizing the release of California Disaster Assistant Act (CDAA) funding. The request for a Gubernatorial Proclamation must be submitted to the Governor’s Office of Emergency Services within 10 days of the local disaster event.
