On behalf of the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), Advocates for Human Potential, Inc. (AHP) is pleased to provide formal notice that Nevada County has been awarded additional Behavioral Health Bridge Housing (BHBH) funding in the amount of **\$2,791,170**.

These funds must be used only for the activities identified in your additional funding survey, as outlined below:

- Infrastructure funds to acquire two currently master-leased homes and provide improvements: **\$2,706,170**.
- Shelter/interim operations funding to serve an additional 60 people at the existing Golden Chain site: **\$85,000**.

To accept and implement this additional award, please revise and resubmit your Program Plan Part 2 (Budget) to incorporate the additional funding no later than **May 11, 2026**. Upon receipt and review of the updated Program Plan Part 2, AHP will initiate the required contract modification.
