RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF AMENDMENT A02 TO THE STANDARD AGREEMENT NUMBER 20-10190 WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CARE SERVICES FOR THE PURPOSE OF IDENTIFYING AND PROVIDING DRUG MEDI-CAL ORGANIZED DELIVERY SYSTEM (DMC-ODS) SERVICES FOR SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER (SUD) TREATMENT IN NEVADA COUNTY TO MODIFY THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS OUTLINED IN THE ORIGINAL CONTRACT: EXHIBIT A A1 - SCOPE OF WORK EXHIBIT A, ATTACHMENT I A1 - PROGRAM SPECIFICATIONS, EXHIBIT B A1- BUDGET DETAIL AND PAYMENT PROVISIONS, EXHIBIT D(F) A1 - SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS, EXHIBIT F A1 - BUSINESS ASSOCIATE ADDENDUM FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1,2020 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2023. WHEREAS, on December 15, 2020, per Resolution No. 20-500, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors authorized the execution of the Standard Agreement Number 20-10190 with the California Department of Health Care Services for the purpose of identifying and providing Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System (DMC-ODS) services for substance use disorder (SUD) treatment in Nevada County and subsequently amended on October 25, 2022 per Resolution No. 22-537; and

WHEREAS, The Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System (DMC-ODS) provides a continuum of care modeled after the American Society of Addiction Medicine Criteria for SUD treatment services, enables more local control and accountability, provides greater administrative oversight, creates utilization controls to improve care and efficient use of resources, implements evidenced based practices in substance abuse treatment, and coordinates with other systems of care; and

WHEREAS, Agreement 20-10190 allows Nevada County to ensure that Nevada County's Medi-Cal beneficiaries have access to a complete array of SUD services to support recovery. Participation in the DMC-ODS will also allow Nevada County to fully utilize the capacity of the recently re-opened Bost House.; and

WHEREAS, the County is in receipt of amendment No. 2 to their Agreement to revise Exhibit A A1 - Scope of Work Exhibit A, Attachment I A1 - Program Specifications, Exhibit B A1- Budget Detail and Payment Provisions, Exhibit D(F) A1 - Special Terms and Conditions, Exhibit F A1 - Business Associate Addendum, for the term of July 1,2020 through June 30, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that Amendment A02 to the Standard Agreement Number 20-10190 by and between the County and the California Department of Health Care Services for the purpose of identifying and providing Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System (DMC-ODS) services for substance use disorder (SUD) treatment in Nevada County in the maximum amount of \$16,252,063 for the term of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2023, be and hereby is approved in substantially the form attached hereto, and that the Director of Behavioral Health be and is hereby authorized to execute Amendment A02 on behalf of the County of Nevada.
