**SUBJECT:** Resolution approving the submission of an application to the US Department of Justice for the 2016 Justice Assistance Grant in the amount of \$15,020 for the period July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017 and acknowledging associated public hearing

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**RECOMMENDATION:** Conduct Public Hearing and Adopt Resolution

**FUNDING:** Funding from this grant if received would impact the Sheriff's Operations Budget for FY 16/17

**BACKGROUND:** Nevada County has participated in the U.S. Department of Justice, Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) program, (formerly the Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Program (LLEBG)) since FY 96-97. Since FY 96-97, Nevada County has received approximately \$550,000 of these grant monies. This formula grant is offered by the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Office of Justice Programs. We are pleased to advise the Board that Nevada County is eligible to receive \$15,020 for the FY 2016-17. The grant requires a public hearing be held to provide an opportunity for community input as well as submission of an application. Due to a very short window of time allowed to apply for this grant, the Sheriff's Office has already submitted an application for this grant.

This grant may be used for technical assistance, training, personnel, equipment supplies, contractual support, and information systems for criminal justice in one or more designated purpose areas. It is anticipated that the 2016 Justice Assistance Grant will be used to fund the purchase of two in-car video systems for our patrol fleet.
