## **OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA**

### **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE TO APPLY FOR THE US DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE (BJA) RURAL LAW ENFORCEMENT VIOLENT CRIME REDUCTION INITIATIVE FOR UP TO \$400,000 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026/27 THROUGH 2028/29, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO EXECUTE THE GRANT APPLICATION AND OTHER APPLICATION DOCUMENTS**

WHEREAS, the US Department of Justice Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) has provided funds for the Rural Law Enforcement Violent Crime Reduction Initiative (VCRI); and

WHEREAS, the VCRI seeks to support local law enforcement in rural jurisdictions to prevent, respond to, and reduce violent crime; and

WHEREAS, local law enforcement agencies and the District Attorney's Office are in need of additional resources necessary to implement a violent crime reduction strategy to solve specific violent crime challenges; and

WHEREAS, local law enforcement agencies and the District Attorney's Office have partnered in a collaborative High-Tech Crimes Task Force to respond to and investigate specific technology-related crimes, reduce the need for local officers to travel out of the area for digital device data extraction, and assist agencies that operate in the region, including state and federal agencies; and

WHEREAS, funds from this program, if awarded, would support the County of Nevada in technological enhancements to reduce violent crime in the form of hardware, software, communications systems, and equipment for the High-Tech Crimes Task Force.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Board of Supervisors hereby approves and authorizes the submittal of an application to the Rural Law Enforcement Violent Crime Reduction Initiative for up to \$400,000, and authorizes the District Attorney to sign associated documents required for this application.
