**SUBJECT:** Resolution approving execution of Amendment No. 1 to the renewal

Training and Consultation Services Agreement # CPE-NCNCE-21-22 with The Regents of the University of California, UC Davis Extension to increase the maximum contract price from \$30,000 to \$70,000 (an increase of \$40,000) and to revise Exhibit "A" Schedule of Services to incorporate facilitation of County Self-Assessment (CSA) activities for the contract term of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. (Purchase Order No. PESP4257)

## **RECOMMENDATION:** Approve the attached Resolution.

**FUNDING:** Services will be funded through available State and Federal sources and department realignment dollars. Services are included in the Department's FY 2021/22 budget. There are no county general fund dollars required in the agreement.

**BACKGROUND:** On July 1, 2021, per Purchase Order Number PESP4257, the Nevada County Purchasing Agent approved an Agreement between The Regents of the University, California, Davis University Extension and the County of Nevada for the provision of training and consulting services for FY 21/22. This Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement incorporates facilitation of County Self-Assessment (CSA) activities which include a Peer Review and Stakeholder meeting to determine areas of strength and areas needing improvement for Nevada County Child Welfare Services. The CSA is part of the California Child and Family Services Review (C-CFSR) System that was formed as a result of the passage of the Child Welfare System Improvement and Accountability Act (AB 636) in 2001. The C-CFSR is designed to improve outcomes for children in the child welfare system while holding county agencies accountable for the outcomes achieved.

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve this amendment as it provides facilitation of Child Welfare's CSA process which guides program improvement. Item Initiated and Approved by: Rachel Roos, LCSW, Director of Social Services
