

### What is government's core function?

Provide Services and Spaces for Community

Agencies provide these functions through **Capital Projects.** 

### Definition

Large-scale, long-term investment projects focused on deferred maintenance, building, acquiring, or significantly improving physical assets like buildings, infrastructure or facilities.

## **Capital Project Financing**

### Options

- Capital Project General Fund Assignment
- Other County Funds
- Tax Exempt Bond Financing (20-30 yr repayment)
- Public Partnership contributions (JPA, MOU, etc)
- Grant awards, Federal earmarks

- Capital projects will be presented to the Capital Projects Sub Committee for review and then brought to the full board for approval.
- Funding for Capital Projects will be discussed and approved in Budget Sub-Committee for inclusion in the County's annual budget. Mid year urgent projects will be approved by the Board through budget amendments.
