SUBJECT: Resolution authorizing submittal of an application for a California

Department of Transportation Division of Aeronautics matching Grant in the amount of \$18,018 to supplement a Federal Aviation Administration Grant for pavement rehabilitation on Taxiway A and Ramps 1, 2 and 5 at the

Nevada County Airport

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the Resolution

<u>FUNDING</u>: The total cost of the series of updates is estimated at \$400,406. The Federal Aviation Administration will fund 90% of the cost, or \$360,366, and CALTRANS Division of Aeronautics will fund 4.5% of the cost, or \$18,018. The remaining 5.5% of the cost, or \$22,022, will be funded by the Airport Enterprise Fund. There is no impact on the General Fund.

BACKGROUND: The Nevada County Airport is responsible for maintaining the airport facilities in a safe and serviceable condition in compliance with Federal Aviation Administration Grant Assurances. Many of the pavements at the airport are now 10-30 years old and have been subjected to significant traffic and need rehabilitation. The design and engineering of the rehabilitation of the taxiway and ramps have been completed by the airport consultant, Brandley Engineering, Inc..

The Board of Supervisors Resolution 22-085 approved the bid documents for the pavement rehabilitation and Resolution 22-157 authorized the application for the FAA grant for the pavement rehabilitation project. This Resolution authorizes the Chief Information Officer to sign the CA Department of Transportation Division of Aeronautics grant application documents in the amount of \$18,018 for the pavement rehabilitation on Taxiway and Ramps 1, 2 and 5. The FAA grant acceptance resolution on this same agenda must be accepted before applying for this matching grant.
