## **OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA**

**RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF A RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO FOR MICROBIOLOGICAL, RABIES TESTING AND OTHER LABORATORY TESTS AND CONSULTATION SERVICES THROUGH THE SACRAMENTO COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH LABORATORY FOR THE NEVADA COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND THE SHERIFF'S ANIMAL CONTROL DIVISION IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$37,500 FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2024 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2027**

WHEREAS, the Public Health Laboratory for Sacramento County is an official State of California Department of Health Services certified public health laboratory established and operated in accordance with the California Code of Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to enter into an Agreement for the performance of public health microbiological testing, rabies testing and other requested laboratory tests, as well as consultation services that will serve to help safeguard the health and well-being of County residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Agreement for Services by and between the County of Nevada and the County of Sacramento, for the provision of requested laboratory tests for the County's Public Health Department and Sheriff's Animal Control Division as well as consultation services, in the maximum amount of \$10,000 per fiscal year for Public Health's usage, and \$2,500 per fiscal year for the Sheriff's Animal Control Division, for a total aggregate contract maximum of \$37,500, for the contract term of July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2027, be and hereby is approved in substantially the form attached hereto, and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf of the County of Nevada.
