SUBJECT: Resolution to approve Program Supplement No. N049 Rev.2 to Administering Agency-State Agreement No. 03-5917R in the amount of \$13,490,000 for the Dog Bar Road over Bear River Bridge Replacement Project – District II

RECOMMENDATION: Approve the attached Resolution.

FUNDING: Funding is provided by the Highway Bridge Program (BRLO) and State Exchange Funds. Project cost is estimated at \$13,490,000.

BACKGROUND: On May 27, 2014, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors signed resolution 14-197 accepting \$525,000 of BRLO funds and on April 26, 2022, via Resolution 22-167, the Nevada County Board of Supervisors accepted an additional \$300,000 in BRLO funds, plus \$3,000 in local funds totaling \$828,000 for replacement of a bridge on Dog Bar Road over the Bear River. The State has additionally prepared Program Supplement Number N049 Rev. 2 in the amount of \$13,490,000 which includes \$3,000 of State Exchange Funds. The Program supplement provides reimbursement guidelines and stipulations which must be followed in order for costs to be eligible for reimbursement.

The Dog Bar Bridge over the Bear River Bridge replacement project is scheduled to begin construction in spring 2025.

Program Supplement Number N049 Rev. 2 must be approved and executed by the Board of Supervisors in order to obtain the project funds.
