OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING FUNDS FROM THE ADVOCATES FOR HUMAN POTENTIAL FOR THE CRISIS CARE MOBILE UNIT GRANT TO EXPAND THE MOBILE CRISIS RESPONSE TEAM WITHIN THE COUNTY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SYSTEM FROM SEPTEMBER 1, 2021 TO JUNE 30, 2025 IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$1,000,000 AND AUTHORIZES AND DIRECTS THE AUDITOR-CONTROLLER TO AMEND THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT'S BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021/22 (4/5 AFFIRMATIVE VOTE REQUIRED)

WHEREAS, an Advocates for Human Potential, Inc. Crisis Care Mobile Unit (CCMU) Grant is available to the Nevada County Behavioral Health Department; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of CCMU is to provide funding to behavioral health authorities to implement, enhance, and support crisis care mobile units through infrastructure development; and

WHEREAS, the monies awarded to Nevada County will be utilized to expand mobile crisis services through additional staffing and infrastructure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, hereby accepts the grants funds in the amount of \$1,000,000 for the Advocates for Human Potential, Inc. (AHP) Crisis Care Mobile Unit (CCMU) for the period of September 1, 2021 through June 30, 2025.

The Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of the County of Nevada and authorizes and directs the Auditor-Controller to amend Behavioral Health's budget as follows:
