



Recreation Collaboration and Advocacy

- ▶Letter to Forest Service Chief requesting action on 3 trail projects March 2025
- ▶Supervisors propose changes/resolution at National Association of Counties (NACo) – July 2025
- ▶CA Jobs First Outdoor Recreation & Tourism Cohort involvement Pines to Mines Alliance
- ▶Nevada County Parks and Recreation Collaborative
- ▶First Nevada County Recreation Fair
- ▶Partnered with Outdoor Alliance to build awareness around a heavy recreation use area, and solicit support for our federal partners - July 2025
- ▶Will continue to submit requests for federal earmark funds

Eastern County Recreation Project Updates




Outdoor Visitor Safety Fund – Station 82


Nevada County
Consolidated Fire District:

- Supported the construction of safe, accessible parking adjacent to Station 82, to improve safety for trail users and residents, and revitalize the congested area in the Highway 20 corridor
- ►Signage is underway
- ▶Future potential for a shaded bus stop, toilets, and a picnic table

Outdoor Visitor Safety Fund – Community Trails Stewardship Program

- Supported the trail stewardship efforts of Truckee Dirt Union through equipment purchases including a mobile tool trailer, powered wheel barrows, public announcement, and communication systems, electronic trail use tracking devices, and first aid kits.
- TDU has hosted 12+ successful community stewardship events utilizing the equipment





Outdoor Visitors Safety Fund – Euer Valley Recreation Improvements

Supporting the restoration efforts of Truckee River Watershed Council (in partnership with Tahoe Donner Association). Tasks underway include culvert removal, bridge across Prosser Creek, installing an equestrian crossing, broad walk construction, and ½ mile of stream restoration

Outdoor Visitor Safety Fund – Enhanced Public Amenities and Environmental Safety for Recreationalists

Supporting Truckee Trails Foundation's Health and Safety Initiative:


- Vault Toilet/Picnic Table At Truckee River Recreational Access point at the entrance to Glenshire subdivision
- Signage at 7 trail locations
- Trail Counters
- Trail Ambassadors
- Portable Restrooms/ Dumpsters at Donner Summit during the summer



Pines to Mines Trail


- Ongoing convening of the Pines to Mines Alliance consisting of USFS, Truckee Trails Foundation, Truckee Donner Land Trust, Gold Country Trails Council, Bicyclists of Nevada County, and the County of Nevada
- Trail work has kicked-off on segment 3 of the trail
- Helped TTF submit a preapplication to the Wildlife Conservation Board for Prop 4 grant





Hirschdale Bridge Project

- ▶Temporary bypass of existing bridge is complete, and will open shortly
- ► Staging under current bridge to facilitate removal of old bridge
- Existing bridge demo scheduled to start midaugust



Van Norden Meadow at Soda Springs

- Nevada County has Earmarked \$500,000 for facilitating the build of a recreation visitor center at the meadow
- ▶RFP for design work is currently open, and selection of a contractor is expected to be complete by September 23rd, 2025
- ▶Scope of Design Work includes a parking area, vault toilets, kiosk with trail information, interpretive signage, picnic tables, structural or tree shaded areas



Local Partner Highlights - TDRPD


Truckee Donner Recreation and Park District

- ► Comprehensive Master Plan Currently in process with Design Workshop
- ▶Summer Camps Serving roughly 245 kids each day in preschool through 8th grade
- ▶ Defensible Space Projects Partner projects with Airport & Fire Districts at Ponderosa Golf Course, West End Beach, Regional Park and Community Recreation Center
- ▶Ongoing Summer Operations West End Beach, Donner Lake Boat Launch, Music in the Park series, adult sports leagues, event hosting, Fourth of July, Community BBQ, and much more

Local Partner Highlights - TDLT


Truckee Donner Land Trust

- Jackass Ridge: 117 acres successfully protected in popular trail area above highway 89
- Donner Lake Rim Trail: Breaking ground on southern stretch from Coldstream Canyon to Donner Summit/Royal Gorge (also part of Memorial Overland Emigrant Trail)
- New trailhead planned at Johnson Canyon, trailhead improvements and new interpretive center at Lower Carpenter Valley.
