SUBJECT: Resolution to accept \$1,365,300 funding for the Construction Engineering and Construction of the 2026 High Friction Surface Treatment Project, Caltrans Project No. HRRRL 5917(124), County Project No. 225039 - Districts I, II, III, IV (Federal Subaward)

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt the attached Resolution approving acceptance of \$1,365,300 of Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funds for Construction Engineering (CE) and Construction (CON) for the 2026 High Friction Surface Treatment (HFST) Project.

FUNDING: The 2026 HFST Project is funded by a HSIP grant (90%) with a County match (10%) from the Road Fund, there is no impact to the General Fund. These funds are partially included in the Fiscal Year 2025/26 Road Engineering budget. Upon returning to the Nevada County Board of Supervisors to award a construction contract, Road Engineering will request to amend both the revenue and expense for this project.

The HSIP grant covers Preliminary Engineering (PE), CE and CON of \$81,000, \$175,500 and \$1,189,800 respectively for a total of \$1,446,300.

BACKGROUND: HFST has been demonstrated to be an effective method to significantly reduce run-off-road crashes on curves. The Department of Public Works has secured a Caltrans HSIP grant to allow the placement of HFST on fourteen curves on County roads for improved safety. Work is scheduled to begin in Summer 2026.
