OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF A RENEWAL CONTRACT WITH THE SALVATION ARMY FOR THE PROVISION OF SHELTER SERVICES AT THE BOOTH FAMILY CENTER FOR CALWORKS FAMILIES, IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT OF \$158,968 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026/27

WHEREAS, the Salvation Army operates the Booth Family Center, a year-round transitional housing facility, intended to provide shelter and support to homeless families in a safe, drug-free, alcohol-free environment; and

WHEREAS, under this agreement, the Salvation Army will provide shelter for referred CalWORKs families in crisis who find themselves without permanent housing, as well as case management services to address the barriers that impact a client's progress towards self-sufficiency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Professional Services Contract by and between the County and the Salvation Army pertaining to the provision of emergency shelter services at the Booth Family Center for referred CalWORKs families, in the maximum amount of \$158,968 for the contract term of July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, be and hereby is approved in substantially the form attached hereto, and that the Chair of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized to execute the Contract on behalf of the County of Nevada. This contract is contingent upon the adoption of the FY 26/27 County Budget. The contract begins on July 1, 2026.
