OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING EXECUTION OF A RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH FIRST 5 NEVADA COUNTY CHILDREN AND FAMILIES FIRST COMMISSION TO REIMBURSE FIRST 5 FOR MEDI-CAL ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIVITIES IN THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT PAYABLE OF \$115,000 FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2026 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2029

WHEREAS, the County would like to enter into a renewal agreement with First 5 Nevada County Children and Families First Commission (First 5) to perform Medi-Cal Administrative Activities (MAA) on behalf of the State Department of Health Care Services to assist in the proper and efficient administration of the local Medi-Cal program by improving the availability and accessibility of Medi-Cal services to eligible and potentially eligible individuals, and their families; and

WHEREAS, the County recognizes the expertise of the First 5 in identifying, advocating for, and assessing the health care needs of Medi-Cal eligible individuals in Nevada County; and

WHEREAS, local public entities (LPEs) and other governmental agencies are eligible to participate in the reimbursement program through an agreement with the County they are located in and this agreement will permit First 5 to receive MAA reimbursement for activities they are already performing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that Agreement by and between the County and First 5 pertaining for Fiscal Years 2026/27, 2027/28 and 2028/29 in the maximum amount payable of \$115,000 for improving availability and access to health services for Medi-Cal beneficiaries be and hereby is approved and that the Chair of the Board is authorized to execute the Agreement on behalf the County of Nevada. This contract is contingent upon the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2026/27 County Budget. The contract begins on July 1, 2026.
