OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION APPROVING NEVADA COUNTY'S ANNUAL MATCH CONTRIBUTION FUNDING PURSUANT TO THE AREA 4 AGENCY ON AGING JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, per Resolution 83-80, the Board of Supervisors approved a Joint Powers Agreement (JPA) between seven California Counties (Nevada, Placer, Sierra, Sutter, Sacramento, Yolo, and Yuba) pertaining to participation in the seven-county JPA for the new Area 4 Agency on Aging (A4AA); and


WHEREAS, under this JPA, A4AA works tirelessly to provide critical services for our aging population within Nevada County; and

WHEREAS, financial support from Nevada County, as well as the other six counties who are parties to the JPA, ensures the quality and content of A4AA's services does not suffer; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that in Fiscal Year 2017/18, A4AA will receive and administer \$695,550 in Federal and State grants for nutrition, transportation, legal assistance, information and assistance, ombudsmen and other supportive services in Nevada County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the annual Match Contribution funding pursuant to the Area 4 Agency on Aging Joint Powers Agreement in the maximum amount of \$30,727 for Fiscal Year 2017/18 be and hereby is approved.

RE: Nevada County Matching Contribution for Fiscal Year 2017-2018

Each year, Agency on Aging\Area 4 (AAA4) works tirelessly to provide critical services for our aging population within Nevada County and the six other counties that comprise our service area. Board approval for continued financial support from each of the seven counties ensures the quality and content of our services does not suffer. This year, the requested match reflects an expanding 60-plus population and the resulting increased service delivery costs.

Nevada County's share of requested match for the fiscal year 2017-2018 is \$30,727. The attached information sheet illustrates the method used to calculate each county's share of match funding. We are providing this information so that Nevada County has time to review the information and include it in the County Budget for the upcoming fiscal year.

It is estimated that in FY 2017-2018 AAA4 will receive and administer \$695,550 in Federal and State grants for nutrition, transportation, legal assistance, information and assistance, ombudsmen and other supportive services in Nevada County. Continued funding is contingent upon meeting the minimum match requirements – estimated to be \$30,727 for Nevada County in FY 2017-2018. Without sufficient funding, AAA4 can no longer provide the services so desperately needed by Nevada's older adult community.
