OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF PLACER FOR BOOKING AND JAIL SERVICES AT THE TRUCKEE JAIL FROM JULY 1, 2025, TO JUNE 30, 2026, FOR A MAXIMUM REIMBURSEMENT AMOUNT OF \$549,257

WHEREAS, the Placer County Sheriff wishes to enter into a contractual agreement with the Nevada County Sheriff for the provision of booking and jail services at the jail in Truckee operated by the Nevada County Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Sheriff agrees to provide personnel and facilities for housing of Placer County arrestees who are arrested by the Placer County Sheriff's Office in the Lake Tahoe area of Placer County; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Sheriff has provided these booking and jail services for the Placer County Sheriff since 2001 with both agencies finding it a mutually beneficial agreement; and

WHEREAS, the current agreement with Placer County has an expiration date of June 30, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Nevada County Sheriff wishes to enter into a renewal agreement with the Placer County Sheriff providing booking and jail services in the amount of \$549,257, for the period July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors, of the County of Nevada, State of California, that the Agreement for booking and jail services with Placer County be approved and authorizes the Sheriff or her designee to execute, on behalf of the County of Nevada, the Agreement between Nevada County and Placer County for the term July 1, 2025, to June 30, 2026, and includes an annual reimbursement amount due Nevada County of \$549,257.
