BACKGROUND: The California Department of Education has administrated the Teacher of the Year Program (TOY) for over 51 years to recognize exemplary teachers who best represent all of California's teachers and symbolize the profession's contributions to quality education. The purpose of TOY is to honor the teaching profession and to heighten interest in teaching as a career. The program affords the opportunity to bring attention to teachers who successfully employ strategies to increase academic success and narrow the achievement gap among a range of students. As such, county offices of education (COEs), school districts, charter schools, professional organizations, and private schools statewide to participate in the TOY Program. Named Teachers of the Year are eligible to be named at the state and national levels.

This year, Kimberlee Veale was named Nevada County Teacher of the Year for her esteemed work for the last 19 years as an educator, mentor, and leader in the Grass Valley School District. In addition to Ms. Veale, eight other teachers were named District Teachers of the Year. On October 16, 2025 I will be attending a special event celebrating our teachers and will be providing certificates to all of our teachers including the attached Certificate of Recognition to Kimberlee Veale as the Nevada County 2026 Teacher of the Year.
