



RESOLUTION No. 15-207

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF NEVADA

ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE FOR THE STATE ROUTE 49 EMERGENCY VEHICLE PREEMPTION (EVP) PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works proposes a project to install emergency vehicle preemption (EVP) at three signalized intersections (Alta Sierra Drive, Lime Kiln Road, and Combie Road) in the SR 49 corridor to improve emergency vehicle response times, improve safety, and provide cost savings; and

WHEREAS, Fiscal Year 2015/16 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), Transportation Enhancement (TE) funds are available for the project; and

WHEREAS, Under Section 15301(f) of the Public Resource Code, Class I projects are categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Nevada County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of the Department of Public Works to file a Notice of Exemption with the Nevada County Clerk's Office for the State Route 49 Emergency Vehicle Preemption (EVP) Project.
